Port Information Update: Weather Predictions – Tropical Storm Eloise

As a result of the predicted strong winds gusting from Tropical Storm Eloise, the office of the Harbour Master Port of Durban might take a decision to evacuate some of the vessels which are on berths more exposed to strong winds. All ships are advised to keep a good watch and put additional moorings to ensure safe mooring of their vessels. All vessels engines to be on immediate standby.

Vessels at anchorage to shift positions to be away from the coastline - suggested min. 3 nm from coast and have engines on immediate standby.
