TARIFF OF FEES

In terms of section 115(2A)(I) read with section 123(2) of the Labour Relations Act, No 66 of 1995, the Governing Body of the Commission for Conciliation, Mediation and Arbitration has repealed the Tariff of Fees published under Government Notice R216 of 23 March 2012 and established the following Tariff of Fees which will take effect on 1 April 2013:

TARIFF OF FEES

The Commission for Conciliation, Mediation and Arbitration may charge a fee in accordance with the tariff shown in Column 3 of Table 1 for the purpose listed in Column 2 of that Table. All fess **exclude** VAT.
